- Majlis Amanah Rakyat (MARA) study loan
- Tunku Abdul Rahman Foundation Scholarship

Sarawak Foundation study loan

- Only students from the state of Sarawak can apply for this loan scheme
- Applicable to all programs
- Approval time takes 3—4 months. Applications are considered unsuccessful if there is no response from Sarawak Foundation after 6 months

Higher Education Charitable Trust Fund

- Only students from Sarawak can apply for this loan scheme
- Applicable only for Engineering programs
- Approval time takes 3—4 months. Applications are considered unsuccessful if there is no response from the Secretariat of the Higher Education Charitable Trust Fund.

National Higher Education Fund Corporation

- Each application form costs RM7.50
- Applicable to all programs
- Interested students need to open a National Education Savings Scheme account with any of the following banks:
 - Bank Simpanan Nasional (BSN)
 - CIMB Bank
 - Agro Bank
 - Bank Kerjasama Rakyat Malaysia
 - Bank Islam Malaysia Berhad (BIMB)
 - Maybank Berhad (MBB)

- Applicable for the following programs:

 - Bachelor of Business

 - Foundation in Business (intending to continue with Bachelor of Business or

Application should be accompanied with an essay about yourself

Tunku Abdul Rahman Foundation Scholarship

- This is a full scholarship scheme covering tuition fees and living allowance
- Applicable only to Bachelor of Business (Accounting) & Bachelor of Engineering (R&M)
- Applications open in March—April and closes in July each year
- Applicants must have a minimum CGPA of 3.00
- Applicants need to attend an interview before being shortlisted
- Applicants must be actively involved in cocurriculum activities

Documents to be attached

Applicants need to submit the following supporting documents together with their application for all loans and scholarship:

- an offer letter from Swinburne Sarawak
- Parents' payslip
- EA form if applicable or yearly income statement
- SPM/STPM/UEC/Foundation Certificate
- Secondary school leaving certificate
- Birth certificate
- Student and parents' IC (photocopy front and back)
- Co-curriculum certificates
- Parent's death certificate if applicable

Failure to submit supporting documents will result in your application being rejected by the sponsors.

Swinburne Sarawak Scholarships

There are three types of scholarships awarded to eligible students each semester namely:

- Swinburne Entrance Scholarship into Foundation and Degree Programs
