## TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

### GENERAL TERMS

1. The scholarship application form must be completed, signed and attached with the required documents as stated in Section F. Any incomplete application form may be rejected.
2. Students who are eligible but fail to apply for the scholarship before the closing date will not be entertained.
3. The **closing date** for scholarship application falls on the **third Monday** after the commencement of the semester.
4. Scholarships will be awarded to eligible students one month after the closing date.
5. A student is only entitled to one scholarship from any organization.
6. The student must be enrolled with Swinburne University of Technology (Sarawak Campus).
7. The University does not take responsibility for scholarship application forms that are misplaced or that do not arrive at the designated department.
8. All scholarships are to be given as course fee rebates only, and cannot be exchanged for cash.
9. The scholarship will be forfeited in its entirety if a student withdraws from the course or is transferred to Swinburne, Australia.
10. Scholarships are non-transferable.
11. The scholarship will be forfeited and given to the next most eligible applicant if the student violates any of the conditions or obtain academic results by means which contravenes the exam rules and regulations.
12. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final. No appeals will be considered.
13. To be effective for the current year.

### ENTRANCE / LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

14. Students applying for **Entrance or Leadership scholarship** must submit the application form direct to **Level 1, Marketing and Communications Department**.
15. The scholarship awarded is based on official academic results and from a single attempt at the examination.

### MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

16. Students applying for Merit Scholarship must submit the application form direct to the **Student Services Unit**.
17. The scholarship awarded is based on official academic results and the results must be from that same semester.
