ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants should have a recognised bachelor's degree in civil engineering, building, architecture, quantity surveying, construction management, real estate and other cognate engineering/technology disciplines, or other equivalent qualification.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Your English Language proficiency should be consistent with Swinburne's policies for admission of local and international students to post-graduate programs. You must produce evidence of written and spoken English proficiency through one of the following:

- IELTS:
 - Band 6.5 (no individual band below 6.0)
- TOEFL:
 - Paper-based: minimum score of 550 (with Test of Written English (TWE) score of 5)
 - Internet based: minimum score of 79, with no individual band below 18.

*IELTS results must not be more than 2 years old at the time of application.
