### **Exploring Malaysia**


Malaysia is a multicultural country of about 31 million people made up of Malays, Chinese, Indians and other ethnic and indigenous groups. While Malay is the national language, English is widely spoken.

The country is geographically divided into Peninsular Malaysia, located on the Malay Peninsula, and the states of Sabah and Sarawak on the island of Borneo.

With well-established infrastructure for banking, communication, healthcare and transportation, Malaysia is one of the most developed countries in Southeast Asia.

The culinary scene is as varied and colourful as its diverse cultures with cafes and restaurants aplenty as well as affordable.

#### **Facilities and services**

As a Swinburne Sarawak student, you will have access to a 350-seat lecture theatre, four computer and science laboratories including two 24-hour computer labs, 46 engineering and research workshops, a multipurpose hall that accommodates 900 as well as several sports and recreational facilities.
