



Living costs

Living and studying in Kuching will require approximately RM30,000 per year for ongoing living costs. This is excluding tuition fees or airfares. It is also important to factor in the cost of moving to Kuching and related costs to when you are settling in. An initial budget of between RM15,000 to RM20,000 should be able to ensure you settle into your student life in Kuching comfortably.

Steeped in traditional beliefs and rich in cultural heritage, festivals and events are held in Kuching and its surrounding areas throughout the year.




Computing & Science Student

Kuching is less than two hours flight from Kuala Lumpur (lesser if you're flying from Singapore), and being a small multicultural city, is the perfect city for quality Australian education at Malaysian costs.

The campus is home to 3,500 students and more than 300 staff. It is also a stone's throw away from a medical centre, government offices, religious houses and banks.

Apart from extensive teaching and laboratory facilities, the Sarawak campus includes:

- Student residences (expected completion mid-2022)
- A library
- Lecture theatre
- Cafeterias
- A gym and indoor sports facilities.



What's right for me: Pathway Options

The beauty of choosing Swinburne is that you get options. You can dip your toe in the water with a diploma before progressing to higher education; start your journey in Foundation studies then progress to a degree; jump into a standard three-year degree, or go straight to work after graduating from a diploma. Or you can even start your study journey now and go on to postgraduate studies – like a master or PhD – down the track.

Foundation

Foundation studies prepares you for direct entry to a bachelor's degree at Swinburne Sarawak or Swinburne Australia, as long as you meet the entry-requirements and pre-requisites. Courses are designed to help you develop fundamental communication, information technology and mathematics skills, along with specialist skills in your chosen stream.

Accounting, Accounting and Finance, and Finance major

If you wish to articulate to the Bachelor of Business (Accounting), Bachelor of Business (Accounting and Finance) and Bachelor of Business (Finance), you must achieve a minimum CGPA of 2.50 in your Foundation year.

Degrees

Standard degrees

Our standard degrees are anything but. They're packed with practical skills, taught by experts in their fields and designed to give you an edge in your field of choice. They're also some of the most flexible degrees around. Sharpen your focus with a major, which will become your primary area of study.

Degrees with honours

In some degrees, you can take on a fourth year to dive more deeply into your major area and develop your research skills. At Swinburne Sarawak, our Engineering degrees have an integrated Honours year.

Double degrees

Double degrees are a great way to broaden your study experience and are highly respected by employers. Generally, they only add one extra year to a standard degree – so you get six years' worth of study in five!

What's in a standard degree?

Our degrees are made up of 24 units of study for a 3-year program and 32 units of study for a 4-year program. A unit is basically another name for a subject and you'll usually take four per semester; eight per year. These units (or subjects) largely fall into one of three categories:



Core units

Students who enrolled in a bachelor degree (regardless of his chosen major) will need to complete these units to graduate.



Major units

These specific subjects make up your specialisation, so pick a major you love!




Elective units

Your remaining units can come from any areas of study. You may choose to:

- Take all the elective units from your course. You'll then end up with a second major;
- Take all the elective units from another course. You'll score a co-major;
- Take four elective units from one area to earn a minor, or
- Mix and match these elective units based on your interest.


Your pathway options




