



At Swinburne, the Swinburne Sarawak Student Council (SSSC) helps new students adjust to university life by organising programs and activities to which students can participate in.


Every Swinburne Sarawak student is automatically a member of the council.

Living costs

In comparison to Kuala Lumpur, living and studying in Kuching is affordable especially for a student. It is estimated that students will require **RM30,000** per year for ongoing living costs, with where you choose to live playing a big part in this estimate.

The figure is intended for a guide only and will vary depending on individual lifestyle, and circumstances. This is also excluding tuition fees or airfares. It is also important to factor in the cost of moving to Kuching and related costs to when you are settling in. An initial budget of between **RM15,000** to **RM20,000** should be able to ensure you settle into your student life in Kuching comfortably.







Foundation in Business

Foundation in Business students wishing to articulate to Bachelor of Business (Accounting), Bachelor of Business (Accounting and Finance) and Bachelor of Business (Finance) must achieve a minimum CGPA of 2.50 in your Foundation year.



What's in a standard degree?

Our degrees are made up of 24 units of study for a 3-year program and 32 units of study for a 4-year program. A unit is basically another name for a subject and you'll usually take four per semester; eight per year. These units (or subjects) largely fall into one of three categories:



Major units

These specific subjects make up your specialisation, so pick a major you love!



Core units

Students who enrolled in a bachelor degree (regardless of his chosen major) will need to complete these units to graduate.




Elective units

Your remaining units can come from any areas of study. You may choose to:

- Take all the elective units from your course. You'll then end up with a second major;
- Take all the elective units from another course. You'll score a co-major;
- Take four elective units from one area to earn a minor, or
- Mix and match these elective units based on your interest.

Our degrees are for 3 years, while Honours degree $\,$ are for 4 years and double degree is 5 years. Students can also take up the ACCA professional program in their 2^{nd} year of study.






