

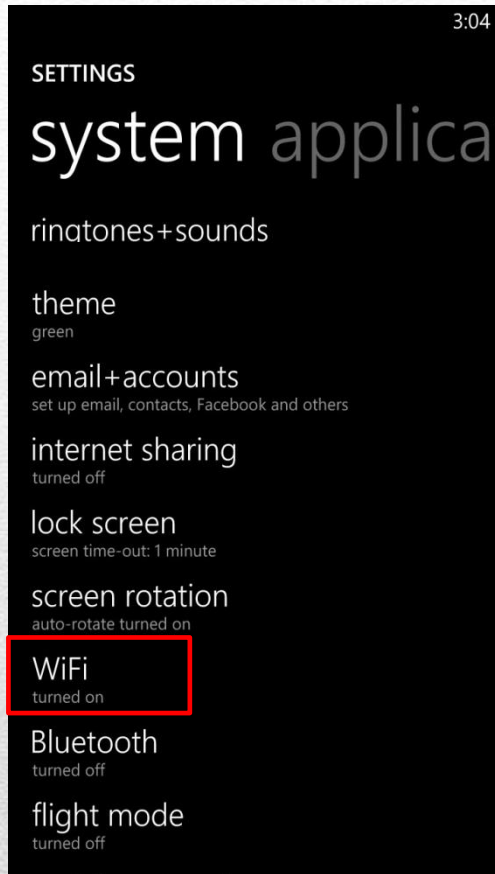


Eduroam

Install Eduroam



1. Go to **phone settings**
2. Tap on **Wi-Fi**




3. Turn on **Wi-Fi**




4. Tap on **Eduroam**

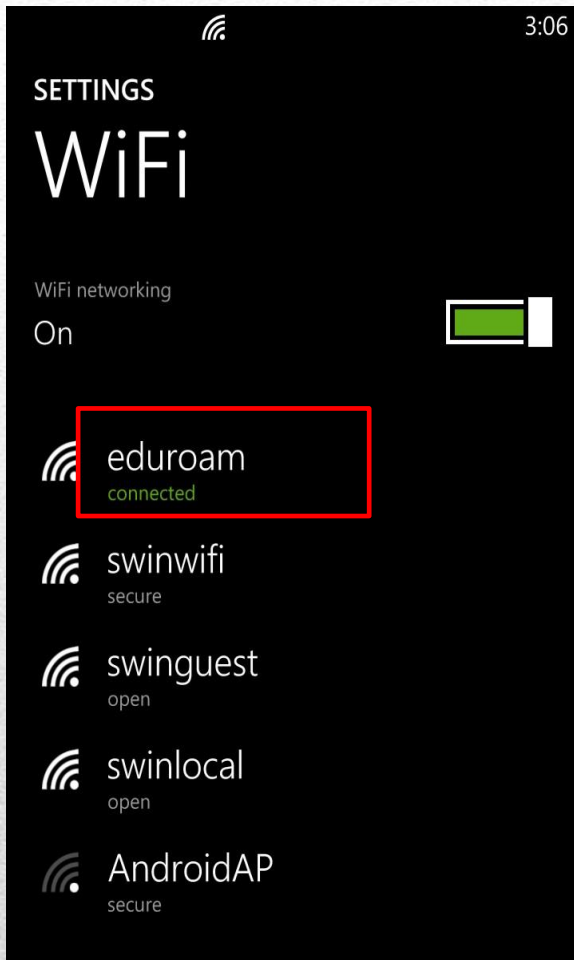

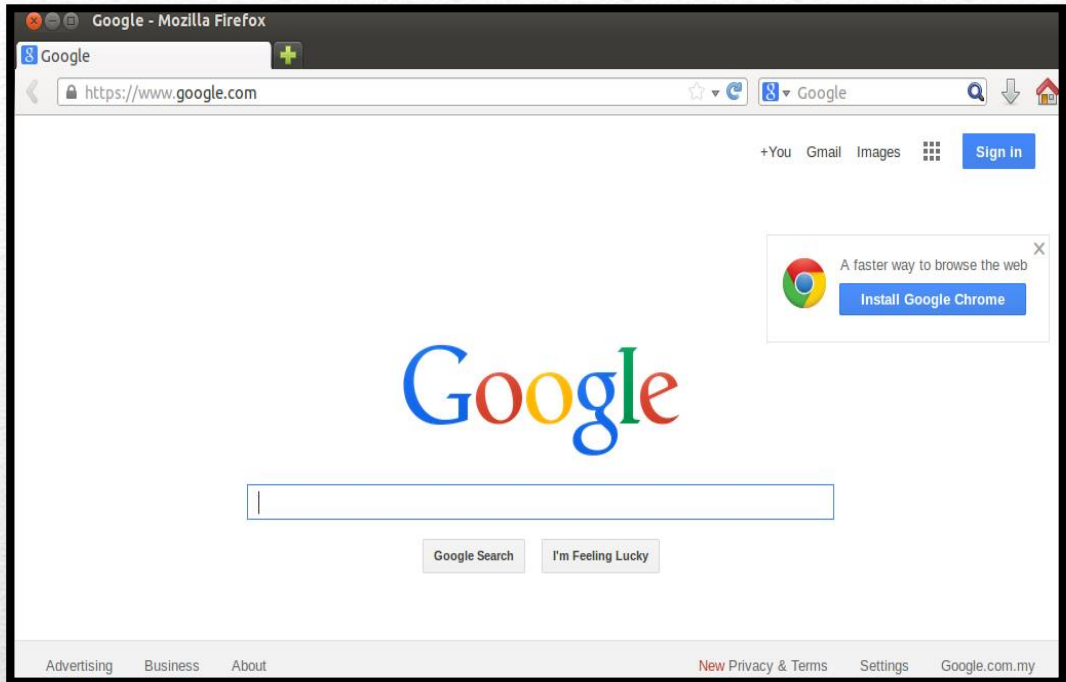
6. Tap **Done**
