At the end of this module, students are required to complete a quiz comprised of 10 questions and achieve a score of at least 90%.

- Malaysian students: Must take and pass the units as a prerequisite for the award of their diploma.
- International students: Must attempt all coursework and final exam as a prerequisite for the award of their diploma.
