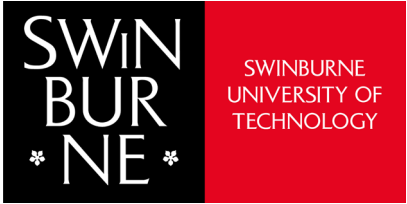

5 Elective Units 62.5 credit points

A combination of elective units or a Minor package.
